CAMP PERSONNEL

The counselors are outstanding Senior High students who have been through a training program. All counselors have already served at least one year as a counselor or camp staff. The counselor's role is voluntary and their main interest is in helping the children grow in the five areas mentioned above. The Bible class teachers and project directors (devotionals, arts and crafts, recreation, etc.) are all talented adults from the Green Lawn congregation who have a strong interest in training young people for Christ. All of our staff has also been through our standard Child Safety Program.
